One day, we will come together again with every member of the Great Cloud of Witnesses (Hebrews 12:1) that God has used so mightily in our lives. So as we say goodbye, know that it is only for a short time and that we can release both Rachel and Joni to serve God according to God's plan.

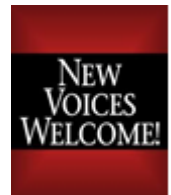
THE GOSPEL ACCORDING TO REUBEN AND MEL

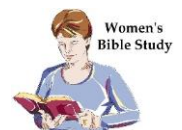
FIRST THURSDAY IS ON HOLIDAY

AUGUST 21, FROM 4:00 P.M. – 7:00 P.M.

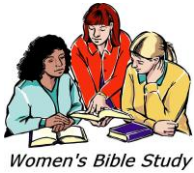
