RE-GATHERING FOR WORSHIP

In March the Session formed a committee to put together the plan that the State of California required for us to re-gather for worship. This committee looked at all of the requirements that the state and CDC had listed in their various proclamations and developed a plan that allowed us to re-enter the sanctuary safely and legally. The CDC and the State of California recently reduced the restrictions, and the Session approved a change in the protocols for worship to be consistent with these new guidelines. Masks will no longer be required for those who have been vaccinated. Those who have not been vaccinated will be advised to continue to wear masks, and any other person who feels more comfortable wearing a mask should feel free to do so. Social distancing will no longer be required in the Sanctuary. Other aspects of worship at TPC will return to those practices in place before the pandemic. We will continue the live stream going forward, so even if you are unable to join us in person, you can be with us online.

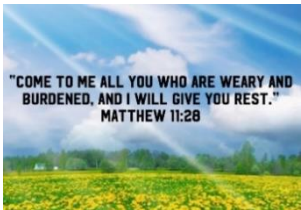
A REQUEST FROM THE STEWARDSHIP COMMITTEE

FUNDRAISER

Tustin Presbyterian Church remains a big supporter of Family Promise of Orange County. We started when Family Promise first opened its doors 10 years ago. We gave \$108,000 to kick off the House of Ruth project in 2016 with Presbytery matching funds. Now we are seeking to donate another \$100,000 in 2021 by raising \$50,000 from the congregation to match Session's contribution of \$50,000 from a dedicated mission project account. The House of Ruth building campaign has already raised \$1,350,000 of the \$3,700,000 required to construct the 7 apartment-style housing unit in the city of Tustin. It is designed to provide transitional housing and a community navigation center for homeless families in Tustin and Orange County.

It is a partnership with the City of Tustin, which donated the land, and HomeAid OC, which will provide donated labor for its design and construction. We will have more information on the House of Ruth available in the patio after each worship service in July. We are off to a good start with more than 30% of our \$50,000 goal pledged.

We sincerely hope you will find this project worthy and donate to this cause. Checks can be sent to the church to the attention of Martha. Please mark checks with House of Ruth Building Campaign (HORBC). Thank you for your consideration of this fundraiser.
